Research on Trends of Alcohol & Other Drug Involvement in Fatally Injured Drivers

Organizers of the 22nd International Council on Alcohol, Drugs and Traffic Safety (ICADTS) Conference (T2019) in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada from August 18-21, 2019, are calling for Abstracts from different countries around the world describing trends of alcohol and other drug presence in drivers killed in traffic crashes.

When submitting abstracts, please describe:

- a) the number of drivers killed each year of the analysis
- b) the number (percent) tested for alcohol and other drugs (specify what drugs are routinely tested for)
- c) the number (percent) found with alcohol by BAC level (e.g. $>.01$; $>.05$; $>.08$; $>.15$ g/dL, etc.), and the number (percent) found with various drugs (cannabis; cocaine; amphetamines; etc.).

Show trends for the last 5-10 years, if possible. Describe countermeasures associated with reductions and factors associated with increases. This data will allow members of individual countries to compare statistics with other countries. ICADTS recommends the attached standard on the reporting of alcohol involvement in fatal crashes.

If enough abstracts are submitted and accepted, a special session on Trends will be held at the Conference.
