Low and Middle-Income Countries (LMICs)

Organizers of the 22nd International Council on Alcohol, Drugs and Traffic Safety (ICADTS) Conference (T2019) in Edmonton, Alberta, Canada from August 18-21, 2019, are calling for Abstracts from different partners for a special session describing results from their research on alcohol, other drugs and road safety in Low and Middle-Income Countries (LMICs). When submitting abstracts, follow the general abstract submission guidelines.

Submissions can focus on a comparison of countries in a region, individual countries, as well as methodological research. Topics of interest are alcohol and drug use among different modes of transportation such as walking, riding a bicycle, riding a powered two-wheeler, or driving passenger cars or transportation trucks and buses. Papers on the prevalence of these behaviours as well as their consequences, and countermeasures will be accepted.

If enough abstracts are submitted and accepted, a special session will be held at the Conference.
